Material

Health hazard with prolonged/repeated exposure

POLYURETHANE **COATING (PAINT/** VARNISH/SPRAY)

- Damage to organs and central nervous system through inhalation/skin contact
- Mucous membrane and respiratory system
- Causes serious eye irritation
- May cause drowsiness or dizziness
- Ingestion may cause nausea, diarrhoea and vomiting

CELLULOSE PAINT

CELLULOSE

THINNERS

- Carcinogenic
- Damage to pregnancy/fertility
- Contains lead
- · Damage to organs (hearing, liver, kidney, nervous system)
- Respiratory/lung damage



- Damage to organs (central nervous system)
- Skin and eye contact may cause irritation



Damage to pregnancy/fertility

BITUMEN PAINT

- Damage to organs (central nervous system, eyes, skin, respiratory system)
- May be fatal if swallowed/inhaled
- May cause drowsiness or dizziness
- May cause skin dryness or cracking

STANDARD THINNER

- · May be fatal if swallowed and enters airways
- Damage to organs if inhaled/skin contact
- Damage to pregnancy/fertility
- Corrosive to eyes
- Can be fatal if inhaled














WASH AC4



- (central nervous system)
- Fatal if swallowed



WHITE SPIRIT

- · Inhaled vapours may have a narcotic effect
- Damage to organs (central nervous system, eyes, skin, respiratory system)
- May be fatal if swallowed/inhaled
- May cause drowsiness or dizziness



Material

Health hazard with prolonged/repeated exposure

SHELLAC-BASED PAINT

- Adverse effects on the kidneys, liver and central nervous system
- May cause serious eye damage
- May cause an allergic skin reaction
- · May be absorbed through the skin
- Ingestion may cause nausea, diarrhoea and

SHELLAC POLISH

- May cause adverse effects on the central nervous system, respiratory tract and mucous membrane
- May cause dizziness, headaches, nausea, sickness, vomiting and diarrhoea
- Moderate irritation, discomfort and possible damage to eyes
- Skin irritation and/or dermatitis

METHYLATED **SPIRIT**

- Narcotic effect/respiratory irritation (after single exposure)
- Can be harmful if swallowed or inhaled
- Causes serious eye irritation
- · May cause damage to organs

FRENCH ENAMEL Mild skin irritation VARNISH

- Irritation and redness in eyes
- · May be irritating to the throat
- Inhalation can cause tightness in the chest and shortness of breath

FLAME RETARDANT LIQUID

- Skin irritation with prolonged exposure
- Eye irritation (minimal exposure)
- · Harmful if swallowed

METALLIC POWDERS

· Irritation to eyes, skin and lungs



STANDARD PAINT STRIPPER

- May cause shortness of breath, tightness of the chest, sore throat and cough
- Skin contact can cause irritation
- Causes serious eye irritation and pain
- May cause irritation to the digestive tract, abdominal pain and nausea

ACETONE



- Vapours may cause drowsiness or dizziness
- Irritation to eyes and may cause redness and pain

LATEX







• Irritation to eyes, skin and lungs

EMULSION PAINT

- Non-hazardous
 - Contact with eyes may cause mild irritation

BRUSHCOAT (IDENDEN, FLINTS)

 Non-hazardous but ingestion may cause obstruction

WALNUT DUST



Non-hazardous but inhalation should be avoided

FULLERS EARTH



- No known delayed effects
- Dust may cause mild eye irritation
- · Non-hazardous but inhalation should be avoided

VERMICULITE

· Non-toxic but inhalation should be avoided

Dust may cause mild eye irritation
